



At Horning Community Primary School, Phonics are taught to the children through a programme called Read Write Inc; a complete literacy programme rooted in the new national curriculum. It is designed to stimulate and create enthusiastic, life-long readers and writers.

Read Write Inc Phonics is a complete literacy programme for children learning to read. It is designed to create fluent, enthusiastic readers who have a secure comprehension of texts, produce confident speakers and keen writers.

In Reception/Y1/Y2: The children will be taught a new sound most days as well as being assessed regularly by the class teachers to check they are keeping up with the programme. The children learn how to orally blend and segment before learning to write sounds and words.

We also use Read Write Inc to support children with SEN in KS2 in order to give them a secure base for their reading and overall academic development.

Since September 2015 teachers plan daily differentiated programmes of phonics tuition and children learn in small groups of approximately 6. This is following poor performance in phonics previously where children were taught in large groups and without enough differentiation. **Our new sessions are excellent, with children engaged and making very good progress. We are looking forward to this year's Y1 phonics screening test so our children can show off the great leaps they are making at present.**
